WHEREAS, the Leslie City Council has determined that the meter ratio based billing will begin July 1 2017; and.

WHEREAS, the City of Leslie has the inherent authority, under Section 16.5 of the City Charter to revise public utility charges by resolution; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the following water and sewer ready to serve charges will be charged to utility customers based on the following meter sizes on a quarterly basis:
